- Kendrick High School is **Beating the Odds**, meaning that it performs better than similar schools.

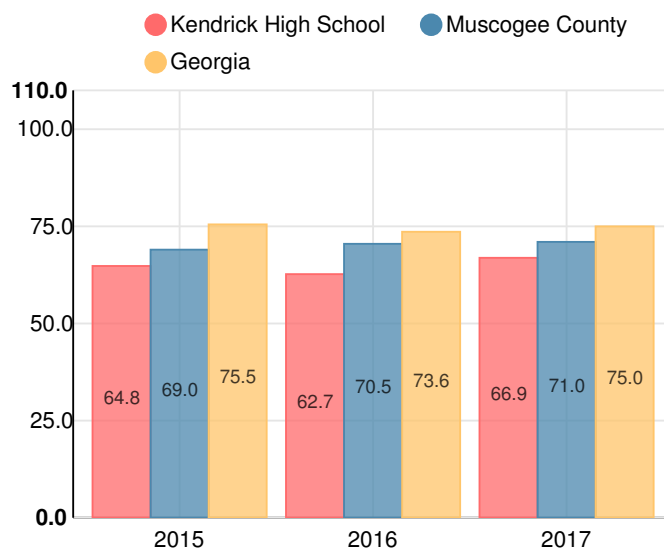

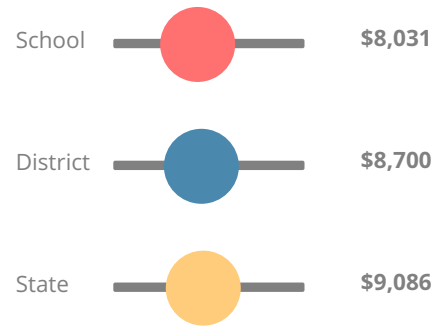
School Climate Star Rating



Financial Efficiency Star Rating

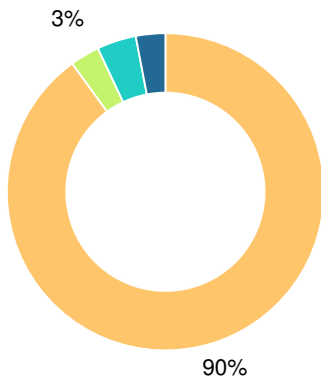


Per Pupil Expenditures



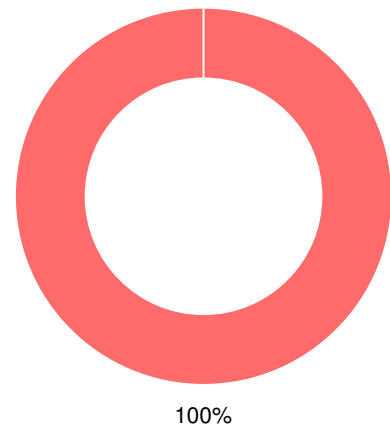

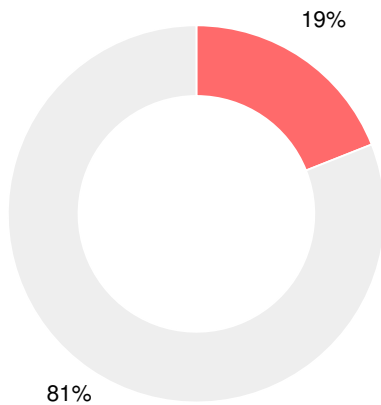

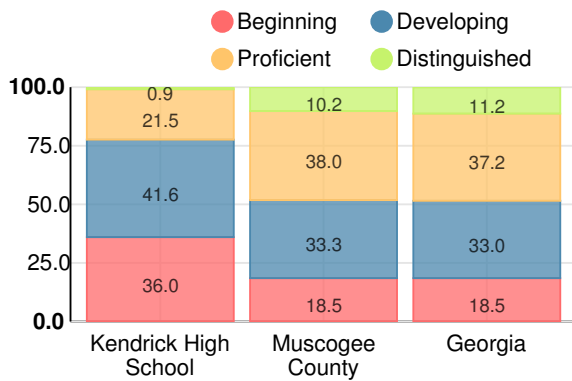

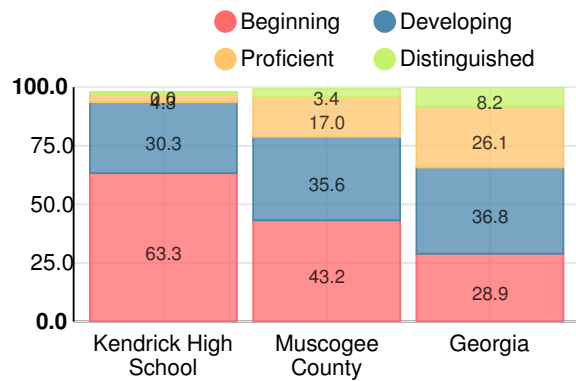

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones



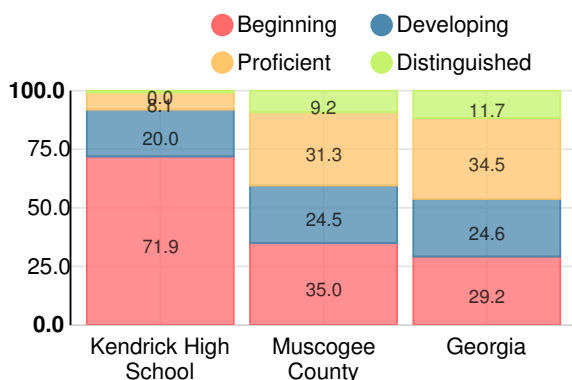
Coordinate Algebra/Algebra I

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones



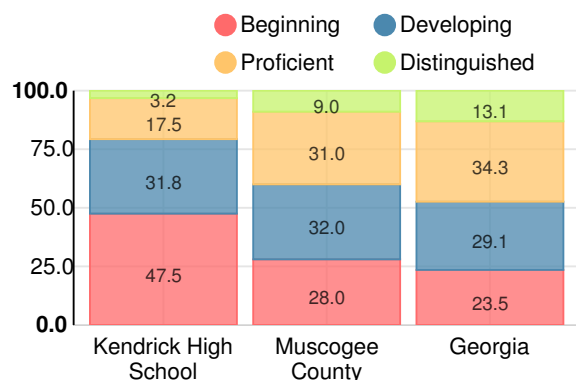
Biology

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones



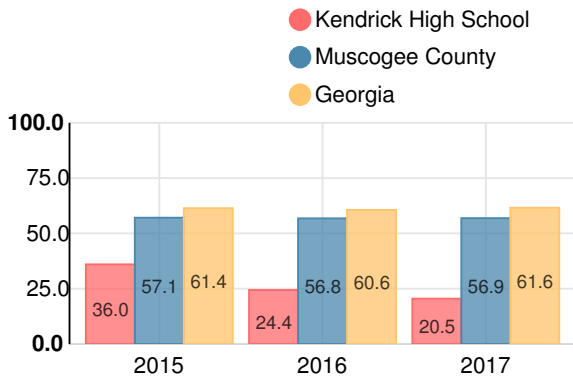
US History

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones



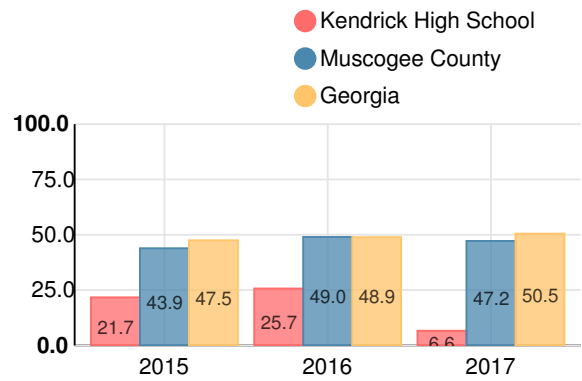
College Readiness

Percent of high school graduates who are college ready

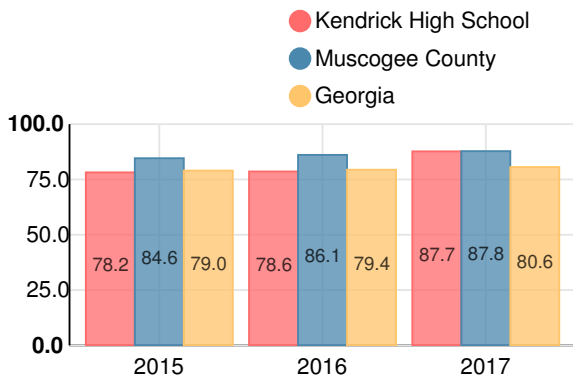


Accelerated Course Taking
