- Richards Middle School is **Beating the Odds**, meaning that it performs better than similar schools.

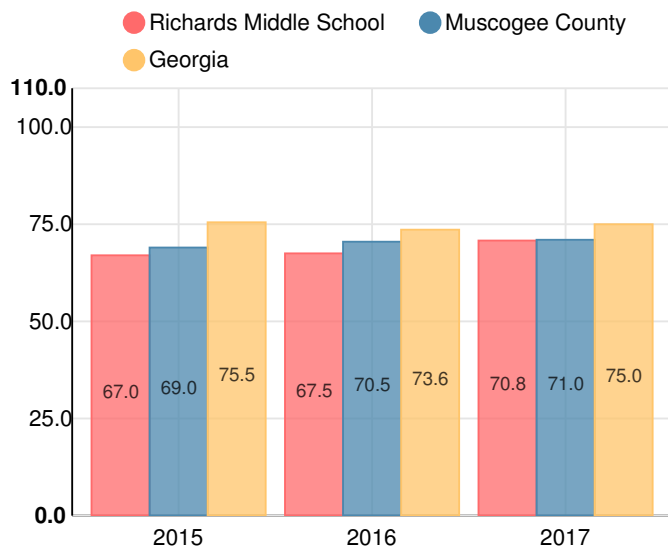

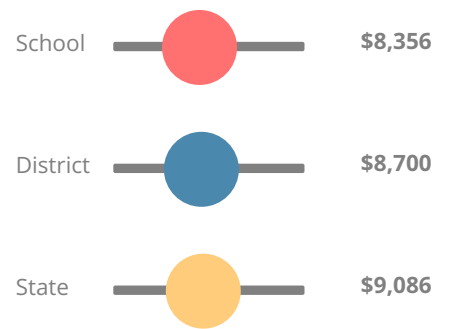

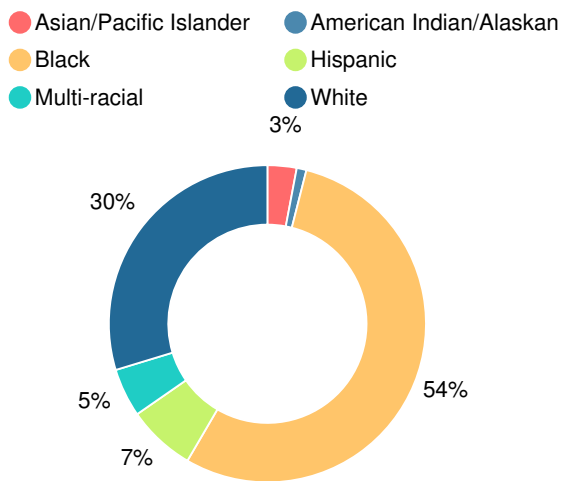
Financial Efficiency Star Rating



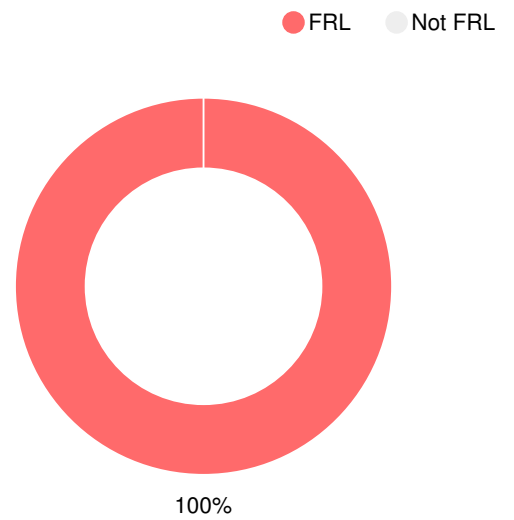

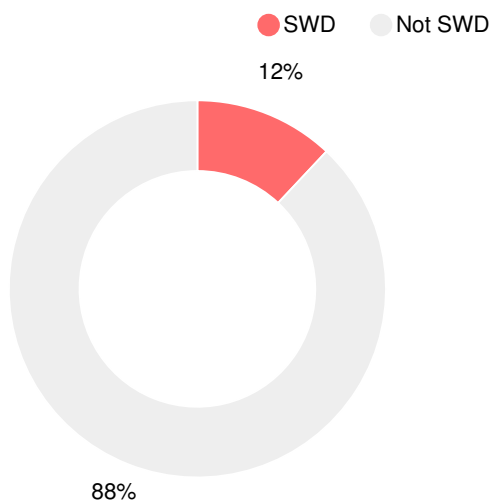

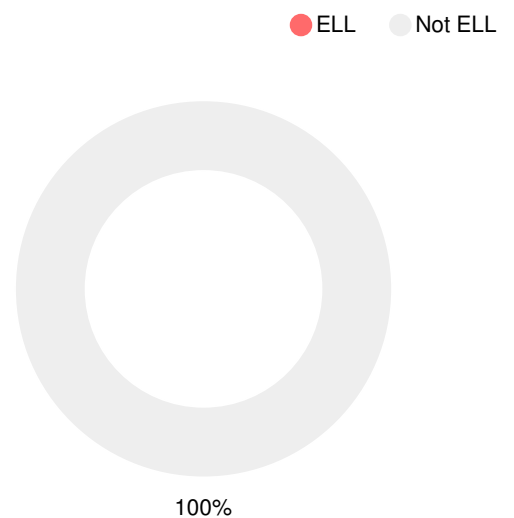

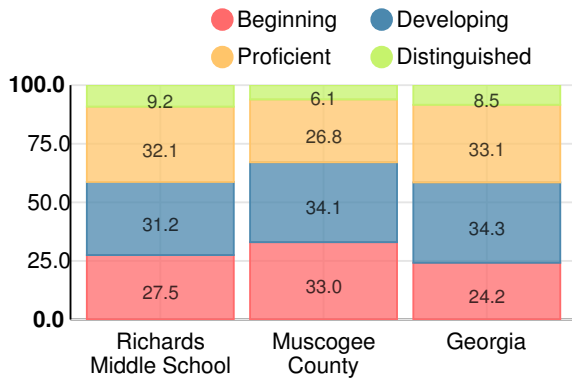

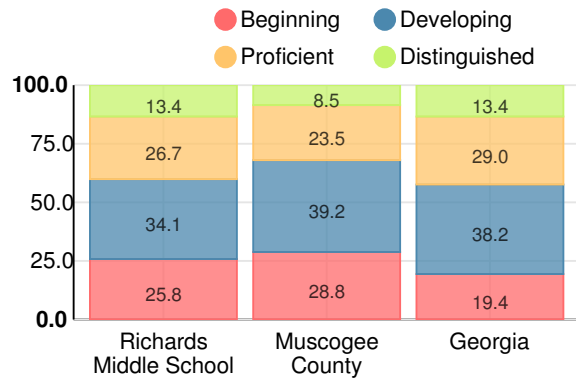

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



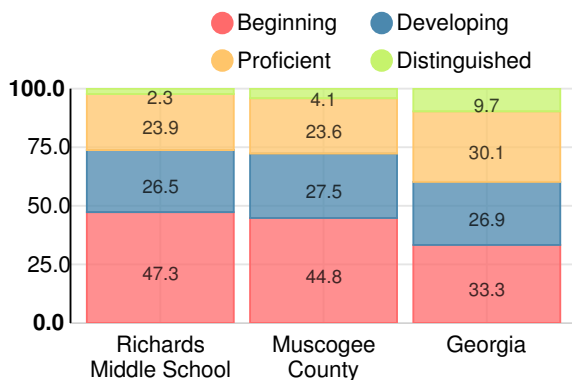

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



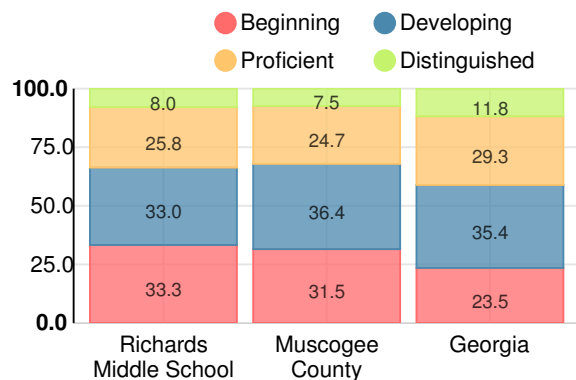
Science
