- Downtown Elementary Magnet Academy is **Beating the Odds**, meaning that it performs better than similar schools.

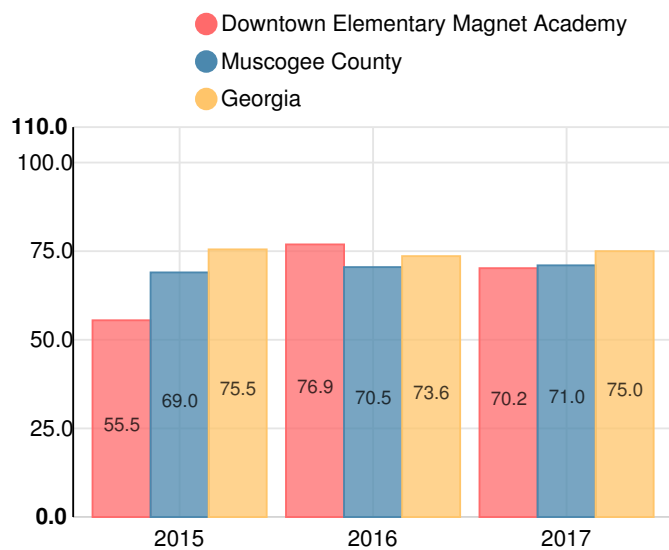

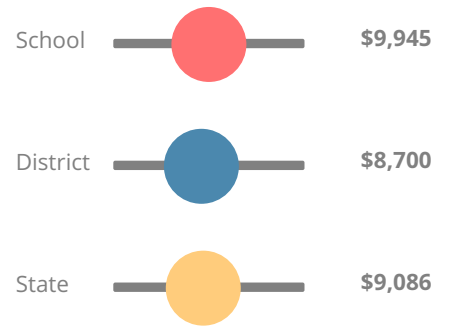

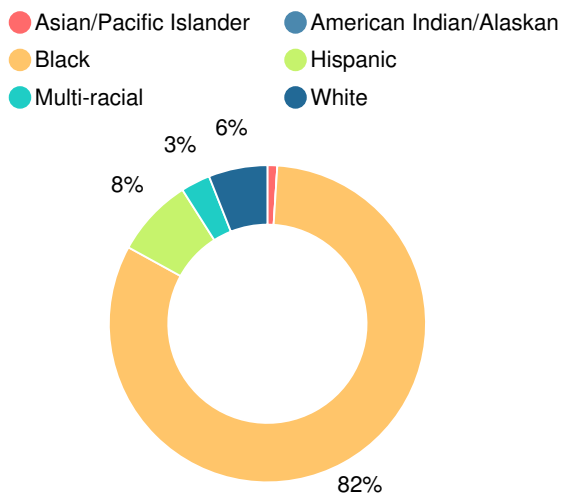
Financial Efficiency Star Rating



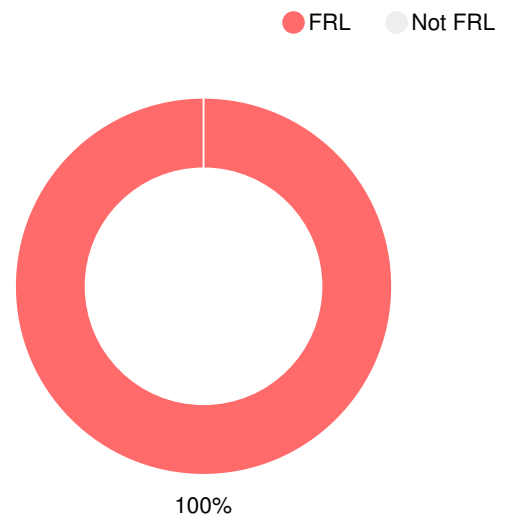
Per Pupil Expenditures



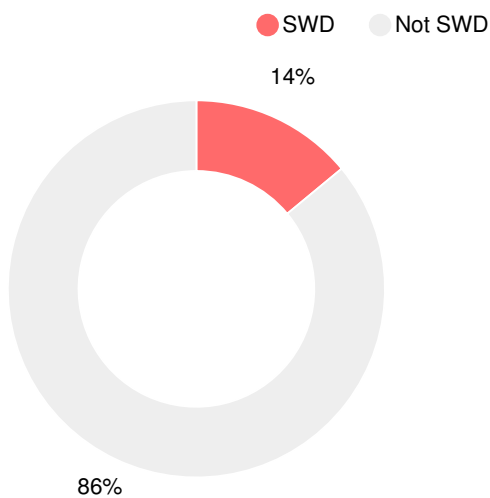

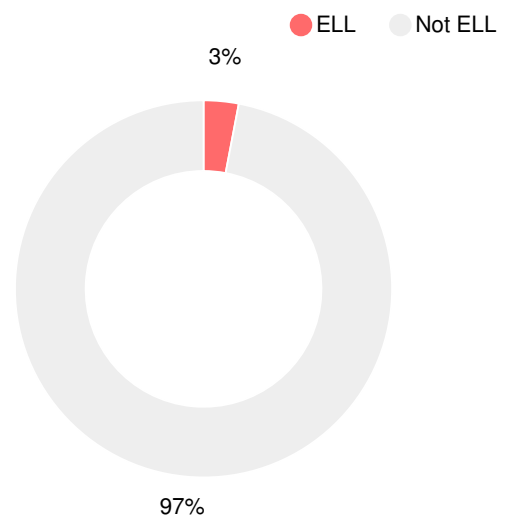

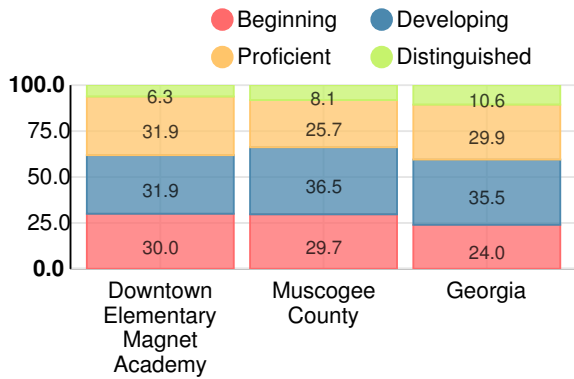

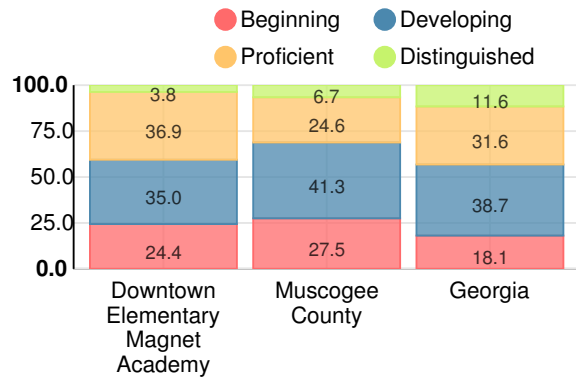

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



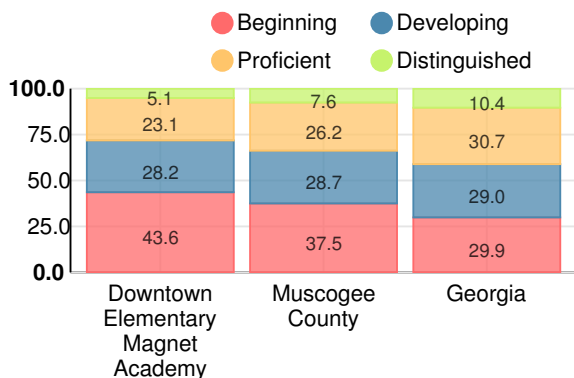

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



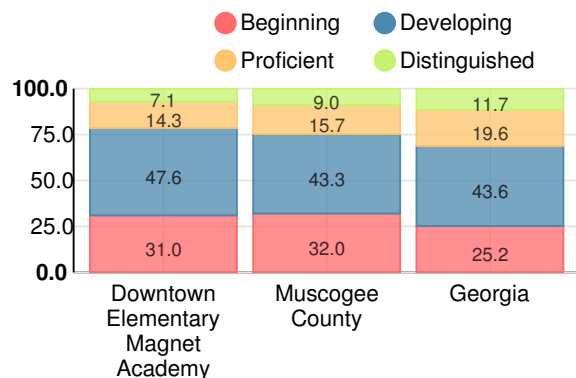

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2017 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



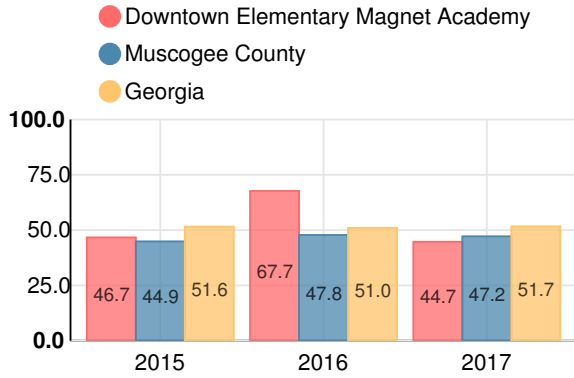
