- Continue implementation of bbyMath strategies to visualize math concepts
- Implement the use of graphic organizers and writing rubrics in all grade levels
- Comprehensive lesson plan structure that includes data, MTSS, and district resources
- Tier 1 instruction that is rigorous, relevant, and differentiated for student success
- Writing every day across all content areas
- Support Team for At Risk Students (STARS) sessions to ensure Tier 2 &3 students receive timely intervention
- Increased Learning Time (ILT) daily
