Woodall Treatment Program Returns to Traditional School Schedule

(Columbus, GA)-Following a polling of faculty and parents of the Woodall Program during the months of December 2009 - March 2010, and recommendation of the Superintendent, Woodall will return to a traditional school schedule for the 2010-2011 school year. The recommendation from each group, parents and staff, was 80% or higher in favor of returning to the traditional Muscofee County School District calendar.

The Woodall Program is a treatment program for severely emotionally disturbed, severely behaviorally disordered autistic children and youth from birth through 21 years of age. Comprehensive services include diagnosis, treatment, periodic evaluation and follow-up. It offers assistance to parents and regular school teachers to encourage a team effort and provide a support system for the child.
