2009 SPLOST Project Nearing Completion George Washington Carver High School Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

(Columbus, GA)- A ribbon cutting ceremony and preview of the new George Washington Carver Science Technology Engineering Mathematics (STEM) High School is scheduled for **Saturday, July 28, 2012, at 1:00 p.m.**, 3100 Eighth Street. The state of the art 2009 SPLOST project is a 225,000 square foot facility with 67 instructional units.
