Back to School: District-Wide Verification Day August 5th

(Columbus, GA)-The first day of school for the 2015-2016 school year is Monday, August 10, 2015. **District-Wide Verification Day is Wednesday, August 5, 2015.** Students and parents should report to the school of assignment on August 5th, to verify the school assignment, complete school documents/forms, medical cards, purchase lockers, pick-up bus passes, visit classes, pay dues & fees, obtain parking decals and meet the staff and faculty. Principals and school administrators may also notify parents of additional grade level verification times and activities. It is important to contact the school of assignment if you have any questions prior to the verification date.

Bus drivers also run assigned routes on the district-wide verification day based on the current listing of completed registrations. Accurate and complete documentation, including the address and contact information, must be provided by parents at the time of registration to complete the registration process and the routing process for buses.

Parents of children who are ***new to the district*** or any parent who may have ***moved since May 2015***, are encouraged to register on-line at www.muscogee.k12.ga.us and to upload the required documents like the child's birth certificate, social security card, and 2 proofs of address, which must be a current utility bill that shows their name and service address *and* a lease, mortgage, or property tax documents. Other registration items needed include the certificate of immunization, certificate of eye, ear, and dental and the last report card if available.

Parents who are new to the district may also register at any school of assignment based on the home address. If the parent lives with someone, the registration documents and the two (2) proofs of address documents from the person he or she lives with is required. Both people must be present at the time of registration, with a current photo I-D to sign an affidavit, which will be notarized at the Central Registration Office.
